

Her academic and artistic researches intertwine in the interest of fraying relationships with physical and virtual spaces. As an actress, she collaborates with directors of different aesthetics. Currently, Ana is dedicated to the *Work in Progress* project, which dialogues with James Joyce's book *Finnegans Wake* (1939) to investigate ways of destabilizing notions of origin.
